

Aberdeen submits block grant request

Notice of Public Hearing

The city of Aberdeen, Idaho is submitting a proposal to the Idaho Department of Commerce for an Idaho Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$250,000. The proposed project is to update Wahlen Park to add a bathroom facility and connecting the walking path to the park for the community to use.

The hearing will include a discussion of the need of the project; the application process; and the project's scope of work, location, funding/budget, schedule, and expected benefits. The application, related documents, and ICDBG Application Handbook will be available for review.

The hearing has been scheduled for September 12th, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. at 33 N. Main Street, Aberdeen, Idaho 83210. Verbal and written comments will be accepted prior to and at the hearing.

The hearing will be held in a facility that is accessible to persons with disabilities.
